Member-Companies' Representatives

Due to the nature of our business activities, we may process personal data of data subjects who provide instructions to us on behalf of companies, organisations, associations, foundations, unions, data subjects employed at such organisations, contractors and advisors of such organisations, directors and shareholders of such organisations. We may also process personal data of data subjects who instruct us on their own behalf but such cases are minimal.

Our Member-Companies' representatives play an important role in operating within the boundaries of our legitimate interests.

<p>Miscellaneous or Ancillary Data</p> <p>Any information we collect during the period of the provision of our services to you or the organisation for which you work (this could be a case-base related matter or incidental to our business relationship with you).</p> <p>This may involve the collection of “special category” data, such as, health, ethnic or racial origin, trade union membership, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs, and in exceptional circumstance, for disclosure exercise purposes, sex life or sexual orientation. We will not collect any biometric or genetic data.
